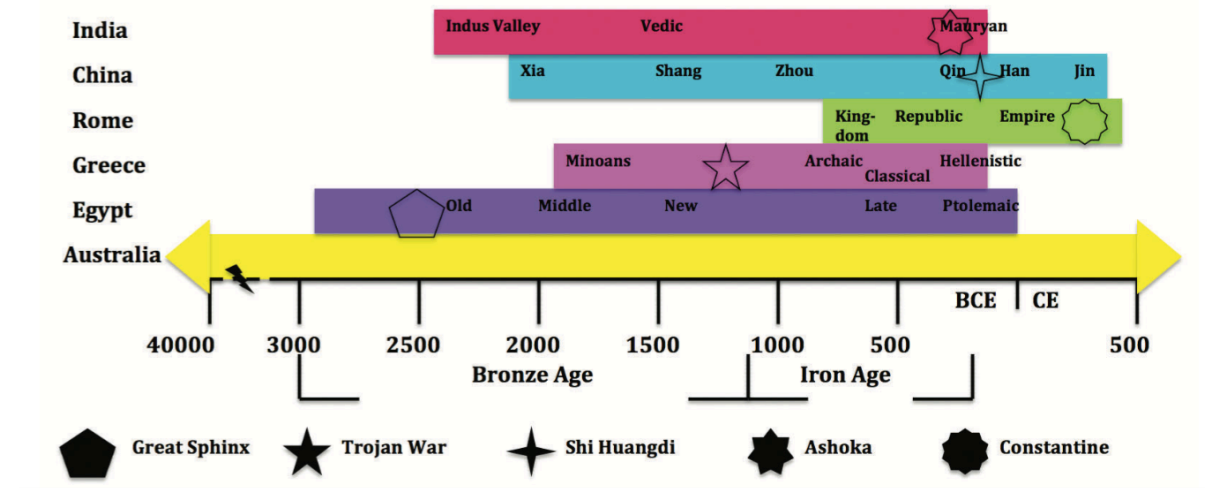


**SOURCE A A timeline of the ancient world**



**Questions 6 – 9 refer to Source A**

- According to Source A which civilisation began with the Minoans?
  - Greek
  - Indian
  - Roman
  - Egyptian
- Which civilisation existed between 265 – 420CE?
  - Jin China
  - Qin China
  - Roman Empire
  - Ptolemaic Egyptian
- According to Source A which of the following occurred during the Bronze Age?
  - Ashoka was King of India.
  - The Great Sphinx was built in Egypt.
  - Qin Shi Huangdi was Emperor of China.
  - Emperor Constantine converted to Christianity.
- What conclusion can be drawn about Indigenous Australia from Source A?
  - It built monuments to its rulers.
  - Its history was divided into periods.
  - The political system changed over time.
  - It is older than other ancient civilisations.

This source and associated questions should be accessible to most students in Years 7 and 8.

The focus of the questions is chronological skills and interpreting sources.

Questions 6 - 8 requires students to interpret a timeline and use the associated legend to answer questions.

Question 9 requires students to make a conclusion based on what evidence is within the source.
